Things You May be Flushing



But Need to Stop Immediately

◆ Medication/Pills

⇒ Many pharmaceutical grade drugs can not be processed at the wastewater treatment plant, which in turn means they can affect environmental water quality in your local waterways.

◆ Paper Towels

⇒ These don't break down in pipes and sewer systems, resulting in clogged pipes.

◆ Dental Floss

⇒ Dental floss balls up in your pipes at home, leading to sewer backups and clogs.

◆ Hair Balls

⇒ Wads of hair tangle up in your pipes and can lead to sewer backups and clogs.

◆ Feminine Products

⇒ These packages may say they're flushable, but they should just be thrown away in the garbage.

◆ Rags or Towels

⇒ Any cloth product should absolutely NOT be flushed.

◆ Syringes

⇒ If a medical condition requires the use of syringes, dispose of them in sharps containers.

◆ Plastic Bags

◆ Grease, Fats, or Cooking Oils

⇒ Once cooled, greases, fats, and cooking oils solidify and cause blockages in pipes. Take advantage of H2GO's C.O.R.E program to safely dispose of these items.

◆ Chemicals or Solvents

⇒ Hazardous materials may not be processed at the wastewater treatment plant and could impact environmental water quality.

◆ Baby Wipes

⇒ While they may be labeled 'flushable', they do not break down causing masses of wipes in sewer systems that can lead to backups.

◆ Facial Tissues

⇒ **Much like many other items, these do not break down and cause wads of facial tissues in sewer systems that can lead to backups.**
